Afterwards we decided that I had gotten a little stomach flu thing as well. So the three days in Mexico were spent really in bed......getting better day by day. Luckily, the day we left, I was able to enjoy the ride home. We went to San Carlos which, it turns out, is 8 hours from Green Valley counting the hours in line at the border and so on. However, It was lovely to be in another physical place.....and I thoroughly enjoyed the company!

Now I am in Silver City NM visiting Vicki Allen. A friend of mine, Jessica Palin (no relationship to the one from Alaska!) is here from the UK. We are doing a low key weekend of percussion and inner work. There are 18 coming! And I feel this is the perfect way for me to complete one stage and start preparation for the next one.

Well, I am in an internet cafe and am running out of battery......Gotta go.

I feel a great surge inside these days and wonder what is going to emerge next!
